

## Region 9 Grant Writing Fee Structure

Non-government organizations will be charged a fee for grant writing services. Fees can be billed hourly, or by project, per client preference.

### Project-Based Fees Ranges

- Foundation Proposals: \$1,500 – \$3,000
- State Proposals: \$3,000 – \$6,000
- Federal Proposals: \$6,000 – \$10,000

### Hourly Fee Ranges

- \$50 to \$90 an hour

*\*prices vary depending on other factors listed below.*

### Services Include

- **Needs Assessment & Research of Grant** includes conducting the initial needs assessment (familiarizing self with the grant to be applied for), researching, and developing list of grant needs; and project proposal – action plan, timeline for completion, and structural framework for applying for the grant
- **Grant Proposal Writing** development of proposal including letter of intent; planning, and writing the proposal; and
- **Related Services** commonly includes program development, overall budget development or program budget development, and grant compliance requirements.

Factors that impact the price are the timeliness and proximity of the deadline, and the amount of work required to complete the grant application. This can include research specific to the funding opportunity, data gathering, message creation, and application writing.
